Curbside recycling collection of Christmas trees from single family homes and town homes in Baltimore County will occur from Monday, January 10, through Saturday, January 29. To ensure collection, residents must place their tree at the front curb/street by Sunday, January 23. Residents must follow a few simple rules when placing Christmas trees out to be recycled:

Set out **bare trees only**.

No trees in plastic bags or wrapped in plastic.

No decorations or tree stands.

Set out trees only at the front curb/street; they will **not** be collected from alleys.

Baltimore County trash/recycling collectors will pick up Christmas trees in standard trash trucks, and deliver them to County facilities to be chipped and later used as mulch. Collection will take place on an ongoing basis and will conclude on Saturday, January 29, unless severe weather causes delay.
